3. Admission Requirements

Applicants to GLOBIS University need to satisfy the following three requirements:

1. Be at least 22 years of age
2. Possess a bachelor's degree or equivalent*
3. Have at least two years of full-time work experience by the time of entrance

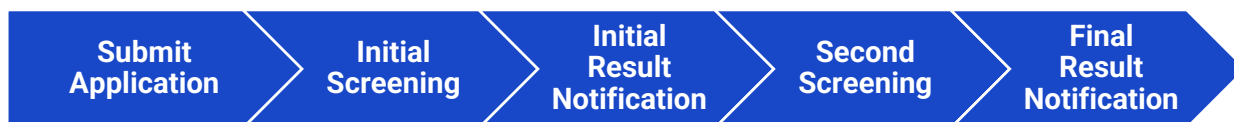
*Applicants are required to meet one of the following criteria by the time of application:

- Received a bachelor's degree from a recognized college or university
- Completed a 16-year curriculum of school education in an institution outside of Japan and possessed a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree
- Received confirmation from GLOBIS University that your academic capacity is equivalent to that of a university or college graduate

If an applicant is 22 years old but does not meet one or more admission requirements indicated above, it is necessary to undergo Preliminary Screening.

4. Application Process



1. Submit Application

Applicants must submit the application documents listed in section 6 through the Online Admission Portal by [18:30, Japan Standard Time \(JST\)](#), on the application deadline indicated in section 5.

Notes:

- Applications submitted by email or post are NOT accepted
- The application fee cannot be reimbursed or deferred to another academic year
- Accepted applications which contain falsified or plagiarized information will automatically result in the withdrawal of acceptance
- The application will not be examined if it is incomplete or contains errors
- Student visa support is not available for the Part-time & Online MBA Program

Applicants can apply to only one of the following programs within the same admission year: *the Part-time and online MBA Program (English)*, *the Full-time MBA Program (English)*, or *the Part-time and online MBA Program (Japanese)*.

2. Initial Screening

Initial screening is conducted using the information and documents submitted for application.

3. Initial Result Notification

The result is announced through the Online Admission Portal. Shortlisted applicants will receive their interview and examination schedule (if required).

4. Second Screening

Applicants who pass the initial screening phase must take a 30-minute online interview (required for all) and a 60-minute online logical thinking examination.

Exemption for the Logical Thinking Examination:

Applicants who have completed the Critical Thinking course in any language at either GLOBIS University or the GLOBIS Management School with a grade of A, B, or C by the interview date will be exempt from taking the Logical Thinking Examination.

Notes:

1. To ensure that the examination is conducted fairly and impartially, the interview will be recorded using Zoom's video recording function. The recorded video and audio will not be used for any purpose other than to conduct the examination and to determine whether the applicant has passed or failed. Recording of the interview by the applicant is strictly prohibited.
2. For any applicants with disabilities who require special considerations for the second screening, contact the Admissions Office before submitting the MBA application.

5. Final Result Notification

The final result will be announced through the Online Admission Portal at 15:00 (JST) on the below dates. Successful applicants can download the Acceptance Letter and Enrollment Guide from the Portal. We are unable to respond to inquiries regarding application results.

6. Application Documents

[Documents written in languages other than English are NOT ACCEPTED](#), except where otherwise prescribed. If the document is written in a language other than English, please provide an English translation signed by a certified translator. The translator's contact information must be included with the translated documents. The applicant cannot undertake translations.

If a different name is stated on a document, evidence of the name change must be uploaded with the application.

Generative AI Usage

GLOBIS provides skill development opportunities for those aspiring to become business leaders. In this era of rapid social change, there is an increasing need to cultivate the ability to think critically. Students must create and develop the MBA application independently as an opportunity to train in this area.

If a Generative AI (including conversational AI) program is used to write the MBA application, we believe applicants will lose the opportunity to examine themselves and their experiences critically, thus preventing the application screener from knowing the applicant's full potential. GLOBIS considers using Generative AI for writing an MBA application unacceptable and should be avoided.

■ Personal Data (Required for all)

- Fill out personal data, work experience, and academic records as requested on the Online Admission Portal
- Ensure to input and show at least two years of full-time work experience and list every work experience after graduation. Work experience during a study period will not be regarded as “full-time” experience unless an acceptable explanation is provided illustrating how both commitments were managed

- **Photo** (Required for all)
 - Upload a high-resolution photo (250 KB to 5MB) taken within three months of the application deadline
 - Use a clear image of the face, front view with a plain background (like a passport application photo)
 - No hat or head covering is accepted unless for religious purposes
 - The photo will be used for the GLOBIS Student ID Card upon enrollment

- **Letter of Recommendation** (Required for all)
 - One letter of recommendation is required
 - The recommender should be a supervisor or a person at a current or previous place of employment or someone who has had a close business relationship with the applicant
 - There are two ways to submit a letter of recommendation:
 1. **Uploaded by the recommender:** by sending a request from the Online Admission Portal, your recommender will be able to receive a link to download the letter form and upload it to the system
 2. **Mailed by applicant or recommender:** if the recommender cannot submit online, applicants can submit the original letter signed and sealed by the recommender to the Admissions Office by registered mail. The letter of recommendation must arrive at the Admissions Office no later than one week before the application deadline. If this is not possible, please get in touch with the Admission Office immediately for guidance.

- **Transcript** (Required for all)
 - Upload a complete bachelor's degree transcript (master's and doctoral degrees are optional)
 - The transcript must include a list of all courses completed, and the grades received for all years of enrollment
 - If the applicant is a Preliminary Screening applicant and does not have a bachelor's degree, it is required to upload a transcript of the highest level of education where the applicant received a diploma (e.g., high school diploma and transcript)

- **Certificate of Graduation** (Only if applicable)
 - If the graduation date and the name of the obtained degree are stated in the transcript, it is not necessary to submit a Certificate of Graduation. Otherwise, a Certificate of Graduation for the bachelor's degree (master's and doctoral degrees are optional) must be uploaded

■ Essays (Required for all)

- Answer the essay questions on the Online Admission Portal (Refer to section 7 for the questions)

■ Evidence of English Ability (Only if applicable)

- All non-native English speakers are required to submit an English test score issued within two years of the application deadline
- TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, Cambridge CPE*, and Cambridge CAE* English proficiency examinations are accepted

*Please select CEFR for the 'Test Type' on the Online Admission Portal

Exemption: Applicants are exempted from submitting an English test score if either of the following conditions are met:

1. Applicants are native English speakers. Select "English" as the native language on the Online Admission Portal
2. Completed an undergraduate or postgraduate degree*¹ from a program taught entirely in English*²

*1: If the exemption relates to your postgraduate degree, please submit the certificate of graduation as evidence to prove that the degree was completed in English

*2: If the undergraduate or postgraduate degree was taught entirely in English, applicants must upload evidence that the university degree was completed in English. Applicants are exempted from submitting this evidence if they graduated from a university in *Australia, Canada, India, Ireland, New Zealand, the Philippines, Singapore, the United Kingdom, or the United States*. Evidence can be an official letter from the university or a link (enclosed in a Word document) to the university's web page indicating that the program was taught entirely in English

■ Evidence of Financial Resources (Only if applicable)

- Non-Japanese applicants (who do not possess a Japanese passport) who wish to apply for a GLOBIS scholarship must submit financial evidence of JPY 3 million to show how they are planning to cover the Part-time & Online MBA Program Tuition
- It is necessary to declare the currently available financial resources by entering the following information on the Online Admission Portal:
 - Personal Savings (required)
 - Supporter's Savings (optional)
 - Other (optional)

Each amount indicated should be accompanied by supporting evidence dated within three months of the application deadline (e.g., a copy of the bank account balance)

- If the total amount of your financial evidence is less than the required amount, it is necessary to indicate a detailed plan to fund the shortfall (e.g., future salary, education loan, etc.) and provide additional evidence to support the plan
- A signed “Letter of Financial Support” is also required if a supporter's savings as financial evidence is submitted. The supporter must be a close family relation (up until and including a second degree of kinship). For example, a parent, a grandparent, a spouse, a sibling, or an aunt/uncle

■ **Residence Card** (Only if applicable)

- All non-Japanese applicants (who do not possess a Japanese passport) who hold a residence status in Japan are required to upload a copy of both sides of the residence card

■ **GLOBIS Scholarship Application** (Only if applicable)

- Refer to section 9 for details

■ **CV** (Optional)

- Upload the most recent CV as a PDF file

■ **GMAT / GRE Score** (Optional, but recommended)

- Upload the official GMAT/GRE score issued within the last five years

■ **Application Fee** (Required for all)

- Applicants living in Japan: JPY 36,000
- Applicants living overseas: JPY 15,000

Policy of Returning Documents

Once submitted, the Admissions Office will not be able to return any documents that have been submitted. This includes the following: letter of recommendation, transcript, translation(s), notarized certifications, CV, evidence of financial resources, and photocopy of residence card.

7. Essay Questions

The following essay questions need to be answered in the application. Applicants should emphasize any international experience where applicable.

Q1. Tell us about a recent work or project experience (within a business setting) which you were passionate about. Describe why you were passionate about the experience, how your skills and values contributed to the experience, and how you worked with others. If the experience entails an element of “creation and innovation,” such as starting

a new initiative by engaging other people or bringing a change to a certain environment, please include it in the essay. (250 to 550 words)

Q2. Tell us about a challenging situation that you have personally faced. Describe concretely what you did about the situation as well as what you learned from it. (250 to 550 words)

Q3. Tell us about a long-term goal or vision for society as a business professional and your career plan to realize this vision. Describe specifically the source of inspiration for your vision, such as an inspiring person, book, or other experience. Describe how GLOBIS University and an MBA degree will help realize your vision and concrete steps you will take to make this vision a reality. (250 to 550 words)

Q4. Tell us about any volunteer activities, social activities, or school groups that you have been involved with. Describe the activity as well as your role and how long you were involved. Additionally, mention any academic and/or business awards you have received. (250 to 550 words)

- The enrollment fee and first installment must be paid at the end of August 2025
- Tuition is paid every six months in four installments
- It is possible to pay in full upon request to the Admissions Office
- If the Pre-MBA application fee of JPY 23,000 has been paid, it will be deducted from the enrollment fee of JPY 80,000 for the Part-time & Online MBA Program
The tuition for credits earned (nano-MBA or Pre-MBA) before admission and recognized as credits at GLOBIS University (including credits earned as a Pre-MBA student) will be deducted equally from the second and fourth installments
- For Pre-MBA courses paid for in a foreign currency, regardless of currency rate fluctuations, the maximum amount to be deducted from the MBA tuition will be JPY 128,000 or JPY 154,000, depending on the course

10. Specialized Practice Education and Training Benefits System

***This benefit applies only to applicants who have paid employment insurance in Japan for a certain period.**

The GLOBIS MBA program has been designated a Specialized Practice Education and Training facility by the Ministry of Health, Labor, and Welfare. If certain conditions are met, applicants can obtain financial support from the government. To confirm eligibility, contact a Hello Work branch. GLOBIS cannot determine an applicant's eligibility for this program.

1. Specialized Practice Education and Training Benefits

If an applicant has paid employment insurance in Japan for at least two years as of the program's start and meets other conditions (e.g., completing the MBA program within two years). In that case, applicants may receive a yearly refund of up to JPY 400,000. In addition, if the applicant is employed and paying employment insurance in Japan within one year of graduation, you may receive a further refund of up to JPY 320,000.

2. General Training and Education Benefits

If an applicant is paying or has paid employment insurance in Japan but does not meet the conditions for the Specialized Practice Education and Training Benefits system (e.g., planning to complete the MBA program in three years), the applicant may still be able to receive the General Training and Education Benefits. It may be possible to receive a refund of up to JPY 100,000.
